Jackson, Wyoming – Ella Olson, 92, died Friday, August 22, 2014 at St. John's Living Center in Jackson, Wyoming.

She worked as a bookkeeper in the family owned Tire and Sanitation business for 30 plus years. In 2011, Ella moved to Jackson, Wyoming.

She enjoyed cooking, after retirement she enjoyed spending time at her cabin in Jackson Hole, spending time with her grandchildren and her great grandchildren. She also liked playing slot machines. Ella was a member of the United Presbyterian Church.

Survivors include her three sons, Gary (Marilyn), Teddy (Jerilyn) and Larry (Deb) Olson; three grandchildren, Gina Olson, Amy Bruce and Jeff Bruce; and four great grandchildren, Malcom Allison, Myllian Allison, Gracelyn Allison and Davis Bruce.

She was always full of fire, and in fact scared me as a child, because she just wouldn't take any guff from anyone. When we were at the cabin, my sister and I were playing in the huge RV they (her and Uncle Buck) had, and somehow we had locked ourselves *inside* the RV. I can't remember actually getting in trouble, but it seemed she recognized we had frightened the daylights out of ourselves, so I don't even remember her being angry. In later years, I'd drive from Denver to visit my grandma and her, and she was always so kind to me as a grownup. My father had had a stroke, and there was a point where we thought he wasn't going to make it (though he did pass away a few years later). Aunt Alma called my sister to give her condolences to us about him. I thought about her a lot in the last few years, wanting to tell her about my own grandson being born and that she was a great, great, great Aunt, in April.
