She started out doing laundry and worked her way up to become a registered nurse. During harvest season she worked extra hours at the sugar factory to help support her family. All this and more while raising a houseful of children who were all well cared for and sent out each day with full tummies and clean clothes that she had hand washed on the washboard. She enjoyed attending church services with her children and her hobbies included knitting, crocheting and gardening. She collected knick-knacks and the shelves of her house were always full of figurines. She was easily persuaded to share stories from her life and told them with passion in her voice. She loved to be outdoors and worked tirelessly in her yard tending her flowers. She spent her final years with her son Raymond in Leesburg, Florida. She was known as a hard worker and a loving wife and mother and spending time with her grandchildren was a special joy to her.
