Jack is survived by his wife Ruth Ann of Torrington, Wyoming; three sons Troy Foos, Chad (Sheila) Foos of Huntley, Wyoming, and Chris (Kenda) Foos of Torrington; his mother Freida Foos of Torrington; a brother Larry (Sherlin) Foos of Torrington; eight grandchildren Kristen (Seth), Kelsey, Elizabeth, Elena, Rebecca, Whitney, Trevor and Trenton; three great-grandchildren Corbin, Cora and Stetson; and adopted family Brad and Lenae Schwartzkopf.
