



## Jesse Cardona

December 2, 1921 - March 29, 2013

Funeral Mass of Christian Burial will be celebrated for JESSE ELIAS CARDONA, 91, at 10am on Tuesday, April 2, 2013 at St. Theresa Catholic Church in Mitchell, Nebraska with Father Thomas Gudipalli officiating. Burial will follow in the Mitchell Valley Cemetery. Jesse died peacefully at his daughter's home in Mitchell on March 29, 2013. A Rosary/Wake will be recited at 7pm Monday at the church. A memorial has been established to the Eye Surgery Foundation in care of Dr. Judd Martin. Visitation will be at the funeral home on Monday from noon till 5pm. Jesse was born December 2, 1921 in Savinal, Texas the son of Cecilio and Andrea (Dominguez) Cardona. He moved to Whitney, Nebraska with his family in 1945. He married Mary Martin in Olathe, Kansas and they lived in Whitney until 1955 when they moved to Crawford, Nebraska where he worked for the Burlington Northern Railroad. They moved to Alliance, Nebraska in 1964 where he farmed for himself before moving to Mitchell, Nebraska in 1967 where he again farmed for himself for two years. He then moved to Henry, Nebraska where he worked for Norm and Ed Middlesworth for forty-two years. Mary died in 2004. In December of 2010 he moved to Mitchell to live with his daughter Cathy Arellano.

Jesse was a member of St. Theresa Catholic Church. He enjoyed hunting, fishing, gardening, and spending time with his family.

Jesse is survived by four sons Joseph Fernandis and his wife Phyllis of Red Bluffs, California, Patrick Cardona and his wife Patty of Oklahoma City, Oklahoma, Eli Cardona and his wife Delores of Laramie, Wyoming, and Robert Cardona and his wife Frances of Torrington, Wyoming; three daughters Chris Lovato and her husband Rumaldo of Scottsbluff, Nebraska, Linda Serda and her husband Ed of Bayard, Nebraska, and Cathy Arellano and her husband Andrew of Mitchell, Nebraska; a sister Sara Montano and her husband Pete of Pueblo, Colorado; thirty grandchildren; fifty-six great grandchildren; and
