At the age of five his family moved to Torrington, Wyoming where he grew up and received his education graduating Torrington High School in 1941. He attended a semester at the University of Wyoming and a semester at Colorado State University before returning to Torrington to help on the family farm. He married Jeannine DesEnfants on June 11, 1948 in Torrington. He farmed and fed cattle in the Torrington area for many years. Al was a member of the Elks, the United Methodist Church where he served on the Board of Trustees for three years, and the New North Platte Irrigation and Ditch Company for eighteen years, fifteen of which he served as their president. He loved to work, ballroom dance, and travel with his family. Al is survived by his wife Jeannine Miller of Torrington, Wyoming; two sons Steve Miller and his wife Liz of Denver, Colorado and Bruce Miller and his wife Andrea of Scottsdale, Arizona; a daughter Joyce Miller of Ft. Collins, Colorado; two sisters Erma Morris of Rock Springs, Wyoming and Dorothy

Metz of Billings, Montana; a brother Allen Miller of Torrington; four grandchildren; and two great grandchildren. He was preceded in death by his parents; and two sisters Wilma Collinson, and Irene Metz.
