While he was serving in the U.S. Navy during World War II, Louise volunteered for an assignment with the phone company in Tucson, Arizona, to support the increased telephone traffic due to the wartime expansion of Davis-Monthan AFB. After the war, Louise and Barney moved with newborn Gary to Torrington where her parents then lived. While focusing on being a homemaker and mother, Louise took pride in her vegetable and flower gardens and also did the bookkeeping for McCone Conoco. She was active in the PTA, and the United Methodist Church, teaching third-grade Sunday School for fourteen years. She served the American Legion Auxiliary in a variety of positions and was elected president of Travis Snow Post four times, and was also District Commander. Louise is survived by her son Gary and his wife Phuong McCone; grandchildren,
