He retired in 1986 and moved to San Diego California. They returned to Torrington in 1996 due to his failing eyesight. Al enjoyed reading and listening to music and was Past Exalted Ruler of the Elks. Al is survived by his wife Anna Mae of Torrington; five daughters, Janet Cocaqne and husband Bill of Nokomis, Illinois, Linda Wood and husband Gary of Castle Rock, Colorado, Barbara Mansoldo and husband Ray, and Marilyn Dalton and husband Tom all of Torrington, and Vanessa Bierma and husband Mike of Austin, Texas; two sisters, Faye Feuquay and Joy McCormick of West Frankfurt, Illinois; six grandchildren, Talon Burton in Iraq,
