“ The last several days have turned my world upside down, was a rollercoaster of emotions, and I have been struggling to find the right words to say to truly recap the feelings that have been running through me.

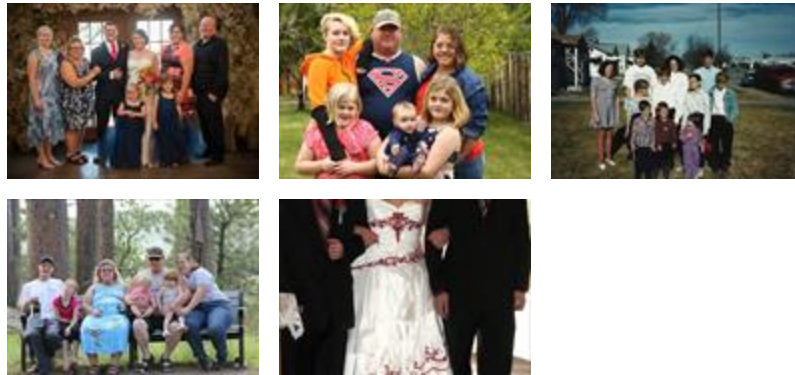
