The couple lived north of Henry, Nebraska on Sheep Creek for a few years before moving to Torrington, Wyoming where they worked area potato cellars from the 1940's to the mid 1950's. Anna and Ralph then built their own home and Anna stayed at home while Ralph went to work for Goshen Irrigation District. Anna entered the Goshen Care Center in 2005. Anna enjoyed fishing and going to auctions; but her real passion was horses. She loved horses and she broke them for her pleasure riding. She is survived by her husband Ralph of Torrington; a sister Lilly Perkins of Cody, Wyoming, three grandchildren, Mike Nash of

Torrington; Pamela Nash of Ft. Collins, Colorado; and Vince Grimes of Galeton, Colorado; and two great granddaughters, Stephanie Nash and Jaszmyne Beverly both of Torrington. She was preceded in death by her parents, one brother, and her only son, Robert.
