He was active in the Lusk Elk's Lodge and the Lusk Fire Department. After moving to Torrington he became involved in the Moose Lodge. He had been in ill health for some time. Blake is survived by a sisters Linda O'Neill of Thornton, Colorado and Dora Mostek and her husband Garrett of Woodriver, Nebraska; brother Albert Ford and his wife Sally of Alamosa, Colorado; aunts Gertrude (Gertie) Poage Eddington of Torrington, Wyoming and Elizabeth Huebotter of Placentia, California; and many nieces and nephews, and many, many friends. He was preceded in death by his father Boyd P. Shearwood; his

mother Margaret J. Carroll Ford; and his step-father Charles Ivan Ford.
