TORRINGTON, WYOMING – Bob Lee White, 71, died Friday, November 13, 2015 at Community Hospital in Torrington.

Bob was born July 13, 1944 in Lincoln, Nebraska the son of Dorence Shelton and Dorothy Ellen (Bacon) White. At the age of 5, Bob moved with his family from Lincoln to a dairy farm north of Torrington, at Gleaner's Union. He worked on the family farm thru high school. He was always interested in 4-H. His mother helped implement 4-H in Goshen County. In 1964, Bob graduated from Torrington High School. After meeting on a blind date, he married Linda Salmon June 20, 1965. Bob worked in Lyman at Kirt Manufacturing, in Gering at Lockwood doing machine work and then back to Kirt's until he retired in 1999, due to the loss of his eyesight.

After retirement Bob was able to spend more time on his leather work. He also enjoyed spending time with his grandchildren. Bob loved coaching and watching his kids and grandkids in all sports.

He was always into fishing, hunting, leather crafting, bowling, kids' sports and 4-H. Bob was a member of the United Methodist Church in Torrington.
