TORRINGTON, Wyoming – Branden Dean Christman, 26, died Monday evening, December 14, 2015, in a fatal car crash between Cheyenne and Torrington.

Memorial services will be held at 1 PM Monday, December 21, at the Rendezvous Center with Bishop Doug Luedke officiating. Burial will follow services in the Valley View Cemetery. Cremation has taken place.

He later became a mechanical technician at Leithead's Appliance Center and at the time of his death was a heavy machinery mechanic at TDS. He was very proud of his job and the fact that he was able to acquire his CDL.

Branden was always a free spirit who was going to live life on his own terms. This was apparent, even as a baby, when he was walking and talking at 8 months. He was a very compassionate person who loved his friends and was

an amazing big brother. His light and his joy was his daughter, Areya. He was also a great stepfather to Achaius. His family meant a great deal to him. Branden loved music. He enjoyed playing the guitar and the piano. His all time favorite thing to do was fish. He really enjoyed spending time in the outdoors. His parents have some amazing memories of family trips when he was young.
