



## CeCelia Cobb

December 17, 1917 - March 23, 2012

CeCelia Ann Cobb, 94, died Friday, March 23, 2012 at Heritage Estates in Gering, Nebraska. Graveside funeral services will be held at 10 a.m. Friday, March 30, at Valley View Cemetery in Torrington with Reverend Ora Dailey officiating. CeCelia was born December 17, 1917 at North Platte, Nebraska the daughter of William and Marie (Buchtel) Hunt. She was the 4th of 10 children. The family moved to a farm north of Ft. Laramie and CeCelia graduated from Ft. Laramie High School in 1937. She married William Cobb at Harrison, Nebraska on July 3, 1937. The couple farmed west of Ft. Laramie, just east of Whalen Dam. They later retired and moved to Ft. Laramie. She was the Ft. Laramie lunchroom manager for 17 years. After they moved to Torrington, she worked at St. Joseph's Children's Home for several years and then at Ben Franklin Store. Her husband, William, died in 1977. CeCelia enjoyed painting, drawing and dancing and was a member of the Southeast Wyoming Art Association. Her artwork has been displayed around the Torrington area. She was also a member of the Lingle Eastern Star and the Torrington Methodist Church. Survivors include a daughter Blye Marie Zaysoff of Sun Lakes, Arizona; a son Robert William Cobb of Lingle, Wyoming; a sister Eleanor Wilkinson of Stillwater, Oklahoma;

five grandchildren; ten great grandchildren and many nieces and nephews. She was preceded in death by her parents; her husband William Newton Cobb; her brothers, Bill, Jerry, Jim, John, Richard, Raymond and her sisters, Agnes and Mary.
