Chuck Lowry, 72, passed away at Regional West Medical Center in Scottsbluff, Nebraska, on May 18, 2014. Colyer Funeral Home assisted the family with cremation. Chuck spent his entire life in service to the public, or as he put it, helping others. In the mid-60's he served his nation for four years as a paramedic in the U.S. Air Force, and then served the citizens and state of Wyoming for two years as a Goshen County Sheriff's deputy and twenty-five years as a Wyoming Highway Patrolman. Following retirement, he accepted the role of Municipal Judge, serving the people and the town of Torrington for the past nineteen years. Through his years, he touched many lives and was greatly respected by many for his kindness and humanity to all.

Chuck's wife Sandra lives in Torrington. His son Tony, wife Jackie and their children Emma and Aidan live in Logan, Utah; son Christopher, wife Kate and their children Ian and Lily live in Boulder, Colorado; and son Jay and wife Theresa live in San Diego, California.

Chuck was born July 14, 1941 on the family farm near Stegall, Nebraska, the son of Elmer P. and Estelle M. Lowry. He was one of nine children and is survived by his siblings, Pauline Clarke of Scottsbluff, Dixie Schoolcraft of Morrill, Nebraska, Linda Zitterkopf and husband Randy of Sioux Falls, South Dakota, Ron Lowry of Stegall, Jim and Brenda Lowry of Torrington, Mike Lowry of Yoder, Wyoming, and many, many nieces, nephews, grandnieces and grandnephews. He was preceded in passing by his mother, father, and sisters Pearl Howieson and Mayrene Chamberlain.
