He was a member of the Lingle Presbyterian Church and the Western History Museum. Dale is survived by his wife Miriam of Lingle, Wyoming; two sisters, Gladys Prickett and her husband Harold of Torrington, Wyoming and Myrtle Jantzen of Lingle; a brother Ralph Bremer and his wife Lenore of Lingle; and numerous nieces and nephews. He was preceded in death by his parents; and three brothers, Glenn, Harry, and Donald.
