Over the years Dan held several positions throughout the plant, and he was able to develop ways to efficiently increase production. Dan was an avid antique Ford enthusiast. In his spare time Dan restored old Fords that included a 1930 Model A Sedan and other Fords from the 1950's through the late 1970's. Dan was very particular in all of his endeavors which also

included woodworking metalworking, photography and mechanical inventions. Dan was also musically inclined, and he taught himself to play classical piano, guitar and banjo. Dan enjoyed the outdoors, hunting, fishing, skiing and snowshoeing. Above all, Dan loved Jesus and enjoyed studying the Bible and spending time in prayer.

Dan is survived by his younger brother Gary J. Fankhauser of Denver, Colorado and by over thirty cousins. Dan was predeceased by his parents, aunts and uncles.
