He enlisted in the army and served three years, attaining the rank of SGT and serving in Germany before being honorably discharged in May of 1974. He met and married Anna Marie Kirchner on November 26, 1975 and they joyfully raised daughter Dana and Dyan. David spent most of his career employed by the US Postal Service. He retired as supervisor of the Torrington office in Feb. 2008. He enjoyed almost every sport imaginable, especially hunting, and fishing, golf, and shooting. Shortly after retirement he worked at Kaufman Glass, forming

friendships that brought him immeasurable joy. David is survived by his wife, Anna of Torrington, WY; daughters Dana (Richard) of Pueblo, CO; Dyan of Goodyear, AZ; mother Beth Eaton and brother Roy (Linda) all of Torrington, and brother Bill (Debby) of Washington; sisters Mary (Andy) Banta of ND and Kathy (Rod) Oliver of Laramie, WY; grandchildren Shayna, Tanisha, and Ruben (RJ).
