Delaney and her Mom moved home to Gillette when Delaney was two months old. Delaney enjoyed life in Gillette until August 16, 2005 when she was diagnosed with a brain tumor. For the next year Delaney and her family lived alternately in Denver, Colorado and Gillette, Wyoming while Delaney fought her illness. Her last two months were spent at home in Gillette playing with her Mom, Dad, and her puppy. Delaney was a bright-eyed, beautiful girl who was full of happiness and spirit. Her favorite companion for any activity was her best friend, 'Purple', the blankie; they were never apart. Delaney loved tea parties with her puppy, Daphne, and

dressing up like a princess. She enjoyed taking walks and swinging at the park for hours, and playing 'hide from Daddy' in her princess castle was a favorite activity. After a long day of play, she enjoyed nothing more than curling up on Mommy and Daddy's bed with 'Purple' and a good princess show. In her last month, Delaney fulfilled her wish to go to Disney World and have tea with a fellow princess. She also met Barney, Cinderella, and all her other favorite characters; and she rode carousels and ate ice cream to her heart's content. Delaney is survived by her Mom and Dad, her puppy, and numerous relatives and friends, who are all blessed to have known and loved this beautiful little girl. We are all comforted to know that Delaney is now an angel, giggling contagiously.
