The couple then moved to Torrington for a year and then returned to Hawk Springs where Deloris went back to work at the Post Office as a clerk until she became the Post Master in 1972. She retired in 1981. She was a member of the Hawk Springs Community Bible Church and was a past member of the Hawk Springs Extension Club. She is survived by her grandson, Mike (Betsy) McBrien of Tennessee, and a granddaughter, Debbie (Scott) Redabaugh of Virginia; and five great grandchildren, Beau, Anne, Kate and Zachary McBrien; and Kristina

Redabaugh. She was preceded in death by her parents, her husband, three sisters and one son, Leslie.
