Dixie moved to Evergreen Court in Torrington in 2018 to continue her life, not to give it up. She called fellow residents her Evergreen family and continued with kind and loving support for others. Dixie's life-long passion was for Jesus Christ. Being a Sunday School teacher, Awana worker, Bible camp supporter, Bible study student and very active congregational member loomed large in her life. 'Prayer Warrior' was her forte. Counseling in the faith benefitted people of all ages. Dixie was a faithful witness to her Lord in a dynamic way as she lived her life. Perhaps her greatest witness was in her passing. God granted her and her family many mercies in this process, and she was anxiously looking forward to her transition. She ministered to and comforted her last visitors until she could no longer. Grandchildren were so precious to her. She and Harry were very involved in their lives, loving and guiding them, and then when great grandchildren came!!!!
