She married Harold Wunder August 1, 1952 in Scottsbluff, Nebraska and in 1953 they moved to Denver, Colorado and then to Scottsbluff where she worked various jobs. They moved to Blair, Nebraska for a short time before moving back to Lingle in 1973. She helped her husband start an appliance repair business and then in 1976 she started working for the Lingle School System as a paraprofessional. She retired in 1993. Donna enjoyed crocheting, cooking, reading, and playing bridge. She was a member of the Lingle Community Presbyterian Church, several bridge clubs, was a Lioness, and served many years as Secretary of the Goshen County Senior Friendship Center Board.
