They lived in Jackson, Wyoming for fifteen summers where she worked at the Grand Teton Photo Shop and the Boyers Indian Arts and Crafts Store. She moved to Torrington, Wyoming in 1987. Doris was a Charter member of the Nebraska Cow Bells, the National Cow Bells, a member of the Torrington Eastern Star, a member of the old original All Saints Episcopal Church, a member of the Indian Paint Brush Chapter of DAR. Her family was always her first love and she was a fan of Wyoming football and basketball. Doris is survived by three sons, T.V. "Tommy" Jones and his wife April of Cheyenne, Wyoming, Jon Jones and his wife Janet of Riverton, Wyoming,

and Barry Jones and his wife Sharon of Torrington, Wyoming; five grandchildren; two step-grandchildren; and ten great grandchildren. She was preceded in death by her parents; her husband; two brothers; and a granddaughter, Codi Lee Jones-Bocanegra.
