When she returned to Goshen County she was employed by the Goshen County Welfare Department. She was married to Edward Heckman on May 8, 1946 in Torrington. They farmed in Goshen County until 1980. They lived all their retirement years in Torrington. Dorothea was a member of First Wyoming United Presbyterian Church, a forty year member of Reed Gobble Unit #63 of the American Legion at Lingle, Wyoming, a lifetime member of Paul A Johnston Auxiliary Unit #2918 of the Veterans of

Foreign Wars, and the Southeastern Wyoming Artists Association. Dorothea is survived by her husband Ed of Torrington; a daughter, Elaine Pollock and her husband Bruce of Gleason, Wisconsin; a son, Stephen Heckman and his wife La Vonne of Torrington; a sister, Helen Curry of Scottsbluff, Nebraska; two brothers, Ben Korb of Strasberg, Colorado and Harold Korb of Carpenter, Wyoming; granddaughter, Robin Taylor; grandsons, Andrew Maddox, Aaron Maddox, Joseph Edward Pollock and his wife Rosita, and Scott Weichel and his wife Shirley; three great grandchildren, Cathryn Weichel, Chad Weichel and Michelle Camila Pollock.
