Dorothy Pearl Greenwald was born January 2, 1923 in Harmony, Colorado the daughter of David and Katherine (Bostron) Ernst. The family moved to Torrington, Wyoming early in her life and she attended school in Torrington, quitting in her senior year to work on the farm. She earned her GED when she was forty years old. She married Willie Greenwald on November 12, 1943 at Barksdale Field, Bossier City, Louisiana near Shreveport on the army base where Willie was stationed. They celebrated sixty-four years together. After Willie's discharge from the army they moved to Lingle, Wyoming and bought a farm east of town where they farmed for forty years and retired in 1983 and moved to Torrington.

Dorothy was a life long member of the First Congregational Church in

Torrington where she taught Sunday school, Vacation Bible School and was a member of the Ladies Aid. She asked Jesus Christ to be her Savior which allowed her to go to heaven and live in the place He had prepared for her. At the age of seventy-seven she was baptized in believer's baptism in full emergence at the Oliver pond west of Lingle professing her faith in Jesus Christ as her Savior along with her grandchildren Jillene Nedens and Gene Brown. She was a thirty plus year 4-H leader, was a member of WIFE organization and the Lingle American Legion Auxiliary. She had a passion to sew and for the color yellow. She liked to attend her children's school events.
