Ed was born April 5, 1927 in Rapid City, South Dakota the son of Harry and Edith (Hollenbeck) Baldwin. He grew up on the family ranch south of Van Tassell, Wyoming in the Prairie Center community. He attended grade school at Prairie Center and graduated from Torrington High School. He served in the US Army for a brief time before receiving a medical discharge. Ed married Wilma Heins from Keeline, Wyoming on September 8, 1950. They raised their family on the Anton Fisher homestead they purchased in 1951. Ed ranched with his family until he retired and moved to Torrington. Ed and Wilma loved to travel and collect antiques where ever they traveled in appreciation of the history told through the articles.

Ed was an active and respected member of the GCSD #1 board, Goshen

County Stockgrowers and Wyoming Stockgrowers, Wyrulec REA, where he served as the Region 7 chair, the American Legion Post #1 Commander in Van Tassell, Farm Bureau and was a member of Our Savior Lutheran Church.
