Butch was born March 6, 1938 in Marysville, Kansas the son of Edward Sr and Phyllis (Upward) Orr. The family moved to Hartville, Wyoming in 1945 and he attended and graduated highschool at Sunrise, Wyoming. He joined the US Navy and served for four years. After his discharge he returned to the family ranch in Hartville. He ranched there until shortly before his death. He married Nadine Barden and they had three sons and were later divorced. He married Deena Testolin at the ranch on August 17, 1991.

Butch enjoyed hunting, fishing, riding his four-wheeler, helping other people and loved to tease. He was a member of the Guernsey Rural Fire District where he had served as chief for several years.

Butch is survived by his wife Deena of Hartville, Wyoming: sons Roy "Peewee" (Kathy) Orr and John Orr of Guernsey, Wyoming and Jerry Joe Orr

of Scottsbluff, Nebraska; step-daughters Kathy (John) Bland of Oklahoma and Jacque King; a sister Jeanette (Bill) Perich of Atchison, Kansas; ten grandchildren; and twelve great grandchildren. He was preceded in death by his parents; one grandson; two brothers; and one sister.
