Erroll was born March 30, 1923 at home twelve miles north of Hershey, Nebraska the son of George and Grace (Dotson) Taylor. He attended school at North Platte, Nebraska. He joined the US Marine Corps in 1941 and served four years. He married Blanche Gosvener on July 1, 1944 in Torrington, Wyoming. He then worked for Union Pacific for five years before rejoining the Marines where he served until his retirement as a Master Gunnery Sargeant in 1979. While in the Marines he served in World War II at the Cliffs of Dover, in Korea, and in Vietnam. After retirement he volunteered at the hospital in Camp LaJune in North Carolina. He also helped build the first disabled American Veteran's facility. After the death of his wife in 1996 he moved to Torrington. Erroll is survived by a daughter Valerie Pearson and her husband of Charleston, North Carolina; a brother Russell Taylor of Elko, Nevada; two grandchildren; and eight great grandchildren. He was preceded in death by his parents; his wife; a brother Stephen Taylor; and a sister Beatrice.
