He retired from work at age 62 and started a small business called "Treats to Go" where he was known to have the best snow cones during "Crazy Days"and Goshen Co. Fair. Esteban enjoyed gardening, fishing, and hunting. He was a member of St. Rose and an original founding member of the Guadalupe

Society. Survivors include his wife Lupe Dominguez of Torrington, WY, five daughters, Beatrice and husband Luis Romero of Kansas City, KS; Rachel and husband Leonel Vazquez and Rosemary Dominguez all of Denver, CO; Yolanda and husband Miguel Varela, and Andrea Dominguez, all of Torrington, WY; and one son Esteban Dominguez and his fiancé Amanda Rose of Torrington, WY; two brothers Antonio Dominguez of Torrington, and Juan Dominguez of Texas; two sisters, Luisa DeLeon and Alberta Dominguez, both of Mexico; grandchildren Cassandra, Emmanuel, and Brianna Romero, Selena Dominguez, Manuel Vazquez, Angelica, Christina, and Jose Varela.
