Eugene is survived by two daughters Donelle Springer and her companion Larry Harmer of Torrington and Brenda Spaulding and her husband Mac of Casper, Wyoming; a sister Pearl Swartz of Spearfish, South Dakota; a brother Albert Springer of Howardwick, Texas; and six grandchildren.
