Lester and Florence had 57 wonderful years together before his death in 2005. Florence did many things throughout her life. She worked at Taylor Law Firm, Cassel Bakery, and Chicken Hut, all in Torrington. But most people know her for her work at Land of Goshen Ministries, which her family organized in 1991. Her care and concern for helping others was no secret, and you could always find her baking cakes, cinnamon rolls, and goodies for people in need, as well as her family. Florence loved carpentry work, crafts, sewing, music, and people. She helped out with organizations of Santa's Helpers, Land of Goshen Ministries, Lighthouse Ministries, and helping others that needed her attention. She is survived by two brothers, Charles McGraw of Torrington, WY., Robert (Betty) McGraw of Port orchard, WA., two sisters, Judy (Ed) Harris of Port Orchard, WA., June (Harry) Robertson of Sand Point, ID., two daughters, Connie (William) White, Lynette Tyrone, two sons, Roger (Evelyn) Snow, and James (Kim) Snow, all of Torrington, WY., nineteen grandchildren, and eleven great-grandchildren.
