She was a member of the Lingle Presbyterian Church, the Hospital Auxiliary, and the Veteran Christmas Club. Gertrude loved sewing and crossword puzzles and working the snack and magazine carts at the nursing home. Gertrude is survived by two sons, Dean Ross and his wife Joan of Newcastle, Wyoming and John Ross and his wife Betty of Torrington, Wyoming; one sister, Betty Rosenkrantz of Medford, Oregon; three grandchildren; and four great
