They moved to Genesed, Kansas in 1949 and then to Guernsey, Wyoming in 1955. She worked at the school lunch room for seven years. From 1961 to 1968 they lived in Cheyenne, Wyoming where she worked for Albertson's Supermarket.

Gladys liked to gamble, play bingo, going to the Guernsey Senior Center of lunch, and sewing in which she made a lot of her daughters clothes. She was a member of the First Christian Church, a member of the Guardian Job's Daughters Bethel for thirty-four years, and a Brownie leader in Kansas for

many years.

Gladys is survived by three daughters Marilyn Thelen of Laramie, Wyoming, Patricia Snyder of Colorado Springs, Colorado, and Brenda Robb of Denver, Colorado; and four grandchildren.
