Funeral services for Glen G. Terrell, 96, will be held at 10 a.m., Thursday, Nov. 3, 2011, at the First Wyoming United Presbyterian Church in Torrington with Rev. Steven Seng officiating. Burial will follow in the Valley View Cemetery. Glen died October 28 at the Goshen Care Center. A memorial has been established to the Scholarship Fund at the South Goshen Presbyterian Church in Yoder, Wyo. Visitation will be Wednesday from 3 p.m. to 7 p.m. at the funeral home and the casket will be open briefly prior to the service at the church. He attended school first through fifth at Cornell School and then attended school at Cotzer School east of Huntley, Wyo. He started working for farmers in the area and then in 1941 he bought a farm near Veteran, Wyo., and worked it until 1981 when he retired and moved to Torrington. He married La Von Golgert on Sept. 26, 1942, in Scottsbluff. Glen enjoyed visiting with people and working his farm. Glen is survived by his son Wayne Terrell of Torrington, Wyo.; two brothers Hubert Terrell and Marvin Terrell, both of Torrington; two sisters Bernice Riley of Casper, Wyo., and Chloa DeVoge of St. George, Utah; and numerous nieces and nephews. He was preceded in death by his parents; his wife La Von; five sisters Jessie White, Leona Nealeigh, Vera Woodbury, Uva Clapp, and Inez Cheeney; three brothers Dale, Elvin, and Raymond; and one infant brother.
