Gordon was born on August 15, 1939 in Lyman, Nebraska the son of Arnold and Ruby (Shirley) Logan. The family moved from Lyman to Sunrise, Wyoming in 1947 where Gordon received his education; graduating from Sunrise High School in 1956. He then worked for the CFI company railroad at Sunrise for a time before joining the United States Air Force where he was stationed in many areas before serving two tours in Vietnam. He also served in Alaska and England; and while in England he met his future wife, Heidi Varditch. The couple married at Reno, Nevada in 1976.

Gordon's military career spanned 22 years with the Air Force before his retirement. He and his wife moved to Fort Laramie, Wyoming in 1985 to help take care of Gordon's mother. While living in Ft. Laramie, Gordon drove school bus for several years. He enjoyed watching the students in their school

activities and sports. Gordon liked fishing, hunting, and gardening. He was a member of the VFW at Guernsey, Wyoming.

He is survived by his wife, Heidi of Torrington; a son and his wife, Mark and Michele Beshoof of Las Vegas, Nevada; a sister and her husband Nyla and Fran Romero of Worland, Wyoming; a granddaughter, Olivia Beshoff and a grandson, Aidan Beshoff both of Las Vegas; and many nieces and nephews. He was preceded in death by his parents, one brother, Bob Grooms; and two sisters, Shirley Troupe and Gloria Weis.
