The couple married on March 3, 1984 in Henderson. They moved to Wisconsin where they lived for a time. Wayne was the first Wyoming recipient of the LVAD Mechanical Heart Pump which he received in Salt Lake City, Utah in 2005. Wayne enjoyed Harley Davidson motorcycles, camping,

and fishing; and he was a collector of Louis Lamour novels. Wayne dearly loved his family. He is survived by his wife Chelly ; a son Nathan Bartow and his fiance Beth Allan; and his daughter, Jennifer Marie all of Torrington; his sister Kathy (Dale) Beaman of Torrington, an uncle Virgil Gladson of Torrington; an aunt, Lois Bartow of Colorado; four nephews, Chris (Christina) Beaman of Casper, Wyoming, Brad (Mareta) Beaman of Torrington; Ricky (Katy) Vandre of Texas and Harlan (Jamie)Terry of New York.
