Harris was born October 26, 1934 on a farm north of Morrill, Nebraska in Sioux County the sixth of eight children of Chauncey and Eunice (Harris) Ludden. While growing up he lived in Morrill and Henry Nebraska, and Torrington, Wyoming. In 1953 he moved to Lander, Wyoming and in October of 1975 he returned to Torrington to work at DSI.
