She grew up and got her early education in rural schools in western Nebraska. In 1935, she moved with her family to Wyoming where she completed her high school education. On August 17, 1940 she was united in marriage to her husband Curtis McCabe in Gering, Nebraska. The couple lived in Torrington, Wyoming where Helen worked for the United Telephone Company as an operator-service assistant from 1949 to May 6, 1962. She then worked at the Torrington Nursing Home for eleven years and later was employed at the L. B. Murphy Clothing Store for eight years. She retired in 1985. The last three years she was a resident at Aspen Wind Retirement Assisted Living Community in Cheyenne, Wyoming where she moved to be closer to her family. Helen loved to work with young people and taught

Sunday School, Vacation Bible School, and Children's Church for many years. She was a member of the River of Life Church. She loved to do crafts and spent many hours at craft shows in Wyoming and Nebraska. Helen is survived by her son, Michael and daughter-in-law Patricia McCabe of Cheyenne, Wyoming; daughter-in-law Myrna McCabe of Gering, Nebraska; grandson CJ McCabe and great grandson Austin of Chadron, Nebraska; granddaughter, Myrna Dean Olivarez and her husband Oscar of Kerrville, Texas; sisters, Dorothy Samson of Payette, Idaho and Ruth Lambert of Boise, Idaho; brother, Glenn Bugher of Paris, Texas; and many nieces and nephews.
