Helen died at the Goshen Care Center on September 19, 2008. A memorial has been established to the Goshen Care Center. Visitation will be on Tuesday at the Colyer Funeral Home from 3pm to 7pm. Arrangements are under the direction of the Colyer Funeral Home. Helen was born October 19, 1913 in Cheyenne, Wyoming the daughter of Cleve and Bessie (Robertson) Hays the second of four children. She moved from LaGrange, Wyoming with her parents when she was two years old. She attended grade school in Morrill, Nebraska moving with her parents to a farm north of Morrill after she finished the eighth grade. She graduated from the Liberty High School in 1931. She taught the lower grades at the Plainview School north of Mitchell, Nebraska for five years. Helen married Marvin L. Rawlings December 14, 1935 in Wheatland, Wyoming. They farmed with his father until 1940 when they moved to the Stegall, Nebraska area where they farmed Joe Long's place for eleven years before buying their own place three miles east of Torrington, Wyoming in 1950. They moved on to it in March 1951. She has resided there until entering Goshen Care Center in 2007. Helen is survived by a son Lonny Rawlings and his wife Sue of Torrington, Wyoming; a daughter Jeanne Coleman and her husband Craig of South Bend, Indiana; a sister, Mabelle "Dutch" Schultz of Omaha, Nebraska; six

grandchildren; ten great grandchildren; and one great-great grandchild. She was preceded in death by her parents; her husband; and two brothers, Donald and Aubrey.
