His tour of duty included Korea, Alaska, Oklahoma, Pennsylvania, South Dakota, Morocco, Oregon, Labrador, Alabama, Vietnam, and back to California where he served as Chief NCOIC of Edwards Air Force Base. After 28 years he and Louise retired and resided in Banning, California until 1991 when they moved to Torrington. Hank is survived by two daughters and sons-in-law, Deborah and Ken Spencer of Wheatland, Wyoming, and Nancy and Sterling Bean of Pleasant Grove, Utah; one brother, Homer Lee Gibson Jr. of Griffin, Georgia; four grandchildren; and seven great grandchildren.
