Herman Siedler, 97, departed this earthly life on his heavenward journey June 3, 2012. Funeral services will be held at Our Savior Lutheran Church in Torrington at 2:00pm on Thursday, June 7 with Pastor Scott Firminhac officiating. Burial will follow in Valley View Cemetery. Herman was born on September 28, 1914 in Pillau, Germany to Gottlieb and Justiene (Sprut) Siedler, the youngest of fifteen children. He married the love of his life, Frieda Lina Meyer, on April 8, 1938, a relationship which lasted sixty-six years, through even the thick-and-thin of European wartime, uprooting and transitioning to life in America, and settling into their new home in Torrington. Seven children were brought into the world through their union as well. Frieda confessed about Herman in her book, *A Life Filled with Memories*, "He was a modest person with a good reputation and a model of good naturedness, which attracted me to him more than anything else." Herman was also blessed with being a child of God through baptism, and was a long-time faithful member of the Our Savior Lutheran Church family. He was also known for his railroad work while still in Germany and, later, for his many years of faithful service as a maintenance technician for the city of Torrington. Herman is survived by his children Eva (Charles) Brumble of Chiloquin OR, Irma (Robert) Miller of Longmont CO, Gerd (Betty) Siedler of Security CO, Gunter (Elfi) Siedler of Colorado Springs CO, Elfriede (John) Stevens of Torrington, and Willi
