Howard was born July 5, 1939 in Torrington, Wyoming the son of Lloyd and Lila (Arnold) Craton. He grew up and started his education in LaGrange, Wyoming and attended grade school at Banner County School and later graduated LaGrange High School in 1957. He married Ellenor Wilkins on December 22, 1957 in LaGrange. He attended Scottsbluff Junior College for two years, then the Colorado State College in Greeley, Colorado where he received his Bachelors in Education. He later attended the University of Wyoming where he earned his Masters Degree in Education. He taught at the elementary school in Hawk Springs, Wyoming before he graduated college. After he graduated college in 1962 he came to Torrington and taught Social Studies, coached basketball, and high school golf. In 1975 he became the assistant Principal and taught Social Studies at the Torrington Middle School. In 1979 he became the Principal at the Lingle-Ft Laramie schools for nine years. In 1989 he became the assistant Superintendent for the Goshen

County Schools for five years and then the Superintendent for three years. Howard retired in 1999.

Howard enjoyed fishing, golf, hunting, gardening, and spending time at the cabin at Glendo Lake. He was a member of the United Methodist Church and served on many committees over the years.

Howard is survived by his wife Ellenor of Torrington, Wyoming; a son Richard "Dick" Craton and his wife Lisa of Brush, Colorado; a sister Loretta Davis and her husband Art of Torrington; a brother Robert "Bob" Craton and his wife Linda of Upland, Indiana; seven grandchildren; and four great grandchildren. He was preceded in death by his parents; a daughter Deborah Eisaman; and a son Steve Craton.
