If you do not feel safe attending these services, the family completely understands and appreciates your thoughts and prayers.

name, instead of sending flowers.

Isidro was born July 10, 1995, in Torrington, Wyoming, the son of Sergio and Alisia Magdalena (Soto) Cortez. He grew up and graduated from Torrington High School and then attended Eastern Wyoming College.

Once in a lifetime you come across someone so vibrant. Isidro was that someone. Handsome, bright and funny are only a few of the many words that described who he was. 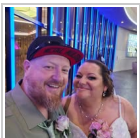
