



## Jack Sedman

December 19, 1929 - October 30, 2023

Jack Sedman, 93, passed away on October 30th at the Goshen County Care Center in Torrington. Memorial services will be held Friday, November 10th at 2:00pm at the First Wyoming United Presbyterian Church with Dereck Jackson officiating.

Jack was born to Colin and Ruth (Brock ) Sedman in Columbus, Nebraska, December 19, 1929. He passed away on October 30th at the Goshen County Care Center in Torrington. Jack held office in the church. He was on the Soil Conservation Board and the Stock Feeders Association Board. He supported the 4-H program and belonged to the Goshen County Stockgrowers Association.

Jack's father was a meat salesman for Swift and Co. The family moved to different towns in Nebraska.

Most of Jack's elementary education was in Hastings, Nebraska. He attended there until the family

moved to Huntley, Wyoming to the original homestead. He was a Junior in High School. While in

Nebraska Jack became a gymnast and won Nebraska State meets. At Huntley he performed exhibition

events at different ball games. He graduated from Huntley High School in 1948. He farmed with his

father and worked for ASCS measuring wheat fields.

Jack and Gertie Kimzey were married in the Presbyterian church in Torrington on October 14, 1950.

Bruce Allen was born. Then they moved to the Dodge Ranch west of Wheatland, Wyoming and a

daughter, Susan Marie was born while living there. In 1956 they moved to the original homestead south

of Huntley, Wyoming. Daughter's Judith Louise and Virginia Ruth were born there. The family drove

trucks, tractors, irrigated and did all the other farm and ranch work.

Jack and Gertie traveled to most every state and in the 1980's Jack became a pilot. They took many trips

in his small Cessna airplanes. They visited friends and families in many states. The whole family

including grandchildren enjoyed the airplane trips.

While living on the farm Gertie drove school bus for 32 years and Jack was a dependable substitute.

They rarely missed attending sporting events, school programs, and other activities for all of their

children and grandchildren.

Jack was an artist. He loved to draw from personal experiences.

Jack loved hunting and fishing with special friends and family. They spent many years at the Kennedy

Ranch and other ranches west of Wheatland. He also brought home a bear from northern Canada and

salmon from Wrangle, Alaska, Canada and Vancouver Island. They were very excited to drag a 210-

pound halibut off the coast of Kenai peninsula. Another exciting spot was off the inside coast of the Baja

peninsula in the Sea of Cortez where the Williams family had a second home. Jack and Gertie moved to Torrington in 2002 and sold their farm of 52 years to their grandson, James.

After retirement Jack purchased a manure truck and a straight truck. He clean corrals and hauled feed

and rock to farmers and ranchers. Then he decided to build a large cabin with the help of family and

friends west Wheatland on the Kennedy ranch. It is a special place for reunions of the large family.

Also, a place for hunting, fishing, and rock climbing.

Jack is survived by his wife, Gertie; his son Bruce (Jane) Sedma; three daughters, Susan (Wylie)McGuire, Judy (Bob) Daily, Ginger (Dave) Hansen; seven grandsons, James (LeeAnn)Sedman, Scott (Kendall) Sedman, Matt Daily, Miles (Karen) Daily, Greg (Ginny) Hansen, Travis (Jyll) Hansen and Sam (Susan) Hansen; seven granddaughters, Karen (Wray) Lovitt, Linda (Eric) Randall, Katie (Travis) Krein, Megan (Lincoln) Iturrey, Abby (Shawn)Campbell, Jill (Adam) Tregemba; 41 great grandchildren and Dixie (Kerby) Berger and his sister Joyce Kennedy.
