Funeral services for JAMES "Jim" HACKER, 62, will be held on Monday, April 9, 2012 at 10:00am at the First Wyoming United Presbyterian Church with Reverend Steven Seng officiating. Burial will follow in the Valley View Cemetery. Visitation hours will be held on Sunday, April 8th at the Colyer Funeral Home Chapel from 5pm to 7pm and the casket will be open briefly prior to funeral services.
