TORRINGTON, Wyoming --- James Addison York, 78, died January 28, 2023 at home with his family by his side.

Funeral services will be held Friday, February 3rd at 1pm at the United Methodist Church with Pastor Jeff Wayland officiating. Burial will follow in the Valley View Cemetery.

He grew up and attended school at Prairie Center and finished high school in Torrington, graduating with the class of 1963. Jim then served two years with the US Army and when he returned he attended Western Nebraska Vocational Technical School which helped him get started with his construction business in Torrington. Jim York Builders was a general contractor for 50 years. Jim never fully retired.

He married Dianne Helzer on February 19, 1994, in Torrington.
