Jimmy became a big brother to Becky in 1989 and Megan in 1995. He enjoyed sports and was involved in soccer, baseball, basketball, track, football, and wrestling. He was also a Boy Scout and participated in the Big Brother/Big Sister Program where he met his “big brother” Shawn Wade. He earned all conference and honorable mention in football and all conference and all state in wrestling his senior year of high school. Jimmy was state runner-up in the 275 lb. weight class. For football he wore jersey #66 with pride and the coaches called him “Scheer Power” Jimmy was baptized at Our Savior Lutheran Church in Torrington. He graduated in 2006 from Torrington

High School and received a certificate for Construction Technology in 2008 for Eastern Wyoming College. He became a member of the Moose Lodge 664 in 2008. He was employed by Norment Security since June of 2008 and was involved in the construction of the prison outside of Torrington. He had also worked at Olson Tire Factory, Western Sugar Corporation, and Torrington Office Supply.
