She served as the secretary of the New North Platte Irrigation and Ditch Company for over eighteen years. She chaired the Mayor's Planning Board for ten years and

was active in PEO and the Methodist Church. Jeannine sold Luzier cosmetics for over forty-five years and was the breakfast bar hostess for the Holiday Inn Express when it opened. She was an accomplished bookkeeper, seamstress, bridge player and ballroom dancer with her husband.

Jeannine is survived by her two sons Steve Miller and wife Liz of Denver, Colorado and Bruce Miller and wife Andrea of Scottsdale, Arizona; her daughter Joyce Miller of Ft. Collins, Colorado; her sister Joan Harris of Torrington, Wyoming; her brother Jack DesEnfants of Scottsbluff, Nebraska; four grandchildren; and two great grandchildren. She was preceded in death by her husband Al Miller; her sister Irene Knight; and her two parents. Jeannine was a wonderful mother- grandmother and will be dearly missed.
