Jennie quilted, and did needlepoint, gardened (especially flowers), and did animal husbandry. Horses were her life. She also enjoyed and competed in rodeos and loved taking care of most any animal. Jennie is survived by a brother Richard Harvey of Torrington, Wyoming; a sister, Daisy Hughes of Wheatland, Wyoming; and leaves behind too many nieces and nephews to count. She was preceded in death by her parents; her
