Jerry Dee Gotchall (Torrington, WY) passed away peacefully February 23, 2022 at Davis Hospice Center in Cheyenne, WY. Cremation has taken place. A celebration of Life will be held later at Lake McConaughy, his favorite place on earth. He was born July 3, 1952, in Goodland, KS to Elburtus Dee Gotchall and Mary Faith (McClain) Gotchall-Elliott. He retired from Burlington Northern-Santa Fe Railroad in 2013. Jerry was an avid fisherman and traveler. He enjoyed many outings with his family and friends.

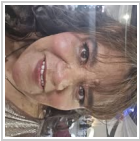

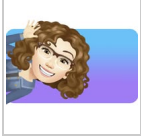

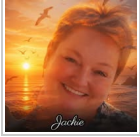
