In 2009 she was appointed by Governor Matthew Mead to serve on the State Board of Cosmetology which she proudly served until 2013.

Judy was a member of the Torrington TOPS organization. She served as the local president for two years and had been secretary for the last four years.

Her biggest achievement was reaching KOPS status and being a past Queen. Her TOPS gals were like an extended part of her family whom she loved very much.

Judy could always be seen with the love of her life, Frank, whom she married in 1961. They enjoyed traveling by air, car and their favorite-cruises. They could even be found at the family cabin where Judy used to hunt right along side Frank. When at home, however, family was always there- from birthdays to every holiday.
